Some information on planning restrictions within the Whitehall Park Conservation Area

Developments requiring planning permission:

- Alterations to or demolition of front boundary walls
- Provision of hardstanding in front gardens
- Enlargement, improvement or alterations to elevations fronting the street, including alterations to external doors or windows
- Alterations to roofs
- Alterations to or removal of chimneys
- Installation of satellite dishes fronting the street
- Construction of porches and side extensions
- Painting of previously unpainted brickwork fronting the street.

Land where developments may not be carried out without planning permission (see map):

ARCHWAY ROAD: 80 - 88, embankment and footpath Alpha Villas, Archway Road.

ASHMOUNT ROAD: All (including Ashmount Primary School).

CHEVERTON ROAD: 2 - 30, 32 - 44, 1 - 89 (i.e. all except Cheverton Lodge).

CRESSIDA ROAD: 1 - 35 (odd), 2 - 56 (even).

DRESDEN ROAD: 1 - 91 (odd), 2 - 96 (even).

FITZWARREN GARDENS: All.

GLADSMUIR ROAD: All.

GRESLEY ROAD: 1 - 41 (odd), 2 - 40 (even).

HARBERTON ROAD: All.

HAZELLVILLE ROAD: 88 - 122, 95 - 113, including Hornsey Lane Estate (i.e. Keir Hardie House, John Wheatley House, Bruce Glasier House, Embay House, Mary McArthur House, Enid Stacey House, Margaret McMillan House, Arthur Henderson House, Caroline Martyn House and the Community Centre).

HORNSEY LANE: 30, 52 - 82, 86 - 98, 100 - 148 (including Fortior Court and the war memorial in St. Aloysius College).

LYSANDER MEWS: Units 1 - 8.

MIRANDA ROAD: All. PAROLLES ROAD: All. PROSPERO ROAD: All.

ST. JOHN'S WAY: 61 - 127 (odd).

SUNNYSIDE ROAD: 69 - 87 (including Manchester Mansions, Redwood Court, Sunnyside

Service Station).

WHITEHALL PARK: All (including St. Andrew's Church Whitehall Park).
